HOW TO PREPARE FOR CHEMICAL TREATMENT

Preparation for Treatment:

Please ensure that the unit is prepared for treatment upon the technician's arrival. We ask that you be mindful of the technician's time, as well as the other residents waiting for treatment. Technicians cannot wait, so if you are not prepared, the treatment will be canceled, and a cancellation fee will apply.

Mandatory Evacuation Period:

All adults and children

All individuals and pets must vacate the premises for a minimum of FOUR (4) hours after treatment. Individuals with allergies, respiratory issues, or who are pregnant should vacate for at least **SIX (6) HOURS**.

Caged Pets Protocol:

Remove any birds and other caged pets (including fish and reptiles) from the residence during treatment. For fish tanks, turn off pumps and filters, and cover the tank with plastic wrap. Wait **24 hours** before reintroducing exotic animals.

PRIOR TO TREATMENT

Clear the Treatment Area

Remove Furniture and Items

Move furniture, toys, pet bowls, and any items away from baseboards, entry points, and areas where ants are commonly found.

Clear Food Sources

Store food in airtight containers or move it to a different location. Clean any spills or crumbs to minimize attractants.

Pet and Child Safety

Relocate Pets

Ensure pets are removed from the treatment area and are kept away until it is deemed safe by the exterminator.

Inform Children Keep children away from the treatment areas before and during the application.

Provide Access

Make sure that all entry points, such as doorways and windows, are accessible to the exterminator.

Identify Infestation Areas

Inquire About Follow-Up

Discuss what steps are necessary after treatment, such as reapplication or monitoring.

Ventilation

Ensure that windows are open to ventilate the space during treatment. This is particularly important if the treatment involves sprays that may produce odors or fumes.



Post-Treatment Clean-Up

Mandatory Evacuation Period:

All adults and children

All individuals and pets must vacate the premises for a minimum of FOUR (4) hours after treatment. Individuals with allergies, respiratory issues, or who are pregnant should vacate for at least **SIX (6) HOURS**.

Caged Pets Protocol:

Remove any birds and other caged pets (including fish and reptiles) from the residence during treatment. For fish tanks, turn off pumps and filters, and cover the tank with plastic wrap. Wait **24 hours** before reintroducing exotic animals.

Monitor for Activity

After treatment, check the areas for any signs of continued ant activity. If you notice any new activity, contact us immediately for follow-up evaluation.

Cleaning

Do not vacuum for 7 days after the treatment then vacuum every 2 to 3 days focusing on all corners and baseboards.

Check for Continued Activity

After treatment, regularly inspect the affected areas for any signs of ant activity. Report any continued issues for follow-up.

No Pesticides or Cleaning Products

Do not spray any pesticides or cleaning products in treated areas after the treatment, as this may lead to control failure.
