Preparation for Treatment:

Please ensure that the unit is prepared for treatment upon the technician's arrival. We ask that you be mindful of the technician's time, as well as the other residents waiting for treatment. Technicians cannot wait, so if you are not prepared, the treatment will be canceled, and a cancellation fee will apply.

Mandatory Evacuation Period:

All adults and children

All individuals and pets must vacate the premises for a minimum of FOUR (4) hours after treatment. Individuals with allergies, respiratory issues, or who are pregnant should vacate for at least ****SIX (6) HOURS**.

PRE-TREATMENT

Identify Infested Area

Locate Activity

Identify areas where assassin bugs have been seen. These insects can often be found in gardens, near plants, or anywhere there are potential prey insects.

Inspect Entry Points

Check for entry points around windows, doors, and cracks in walls where assassin bugs may be entering your home.

Clear the Treatment Areas

Remove Debris

Clear away any debris, such as leaves piles of wood, or heavy vegetation around your home's foundation. This reduces hiding spots for assassin bugs.

Trim Vegetation

Trim overgrown shrubs and plants, especially those close to your home, to create a barrier and limit their access to your living space.

Plan for Pets and Children

Relocate Pets

Keep pets indoors or in a secure location away from treated areas during and shortly after the extermination process. This prevents any stress or exposure to treated areas.

Child Safety

Ensure that children are kept away from treatment areas until the exterminator indicates it is safe to return.

Post-Treatment Guidelines

Monitor for Activity

After treatment, check areas for any signs of continued assassin bug activity. Report any ongoing issues immediately.

No Pesticides or Cleaning Products:

DO NOT spray any pesticides or cleaning products in treated areas after the treatment. Doing so may result in control failure.

Prevent Future Infestations

Maintain a Clean Environment

Regularly clean garden beds and landscape areas to eliminate potential food sources and hiding spots for assassin bugs and other pests.

Control Weeds

Keep weeds under control as they can provide shelter and breeding grounds for various insects.

Regular Inspections

Conduct periodic checks around your home for signs of insects, including assassin bugs, and take immediate action if you notice any activity.
