PRE-TREATMENT PREPARATION

Preparation for Treatment:

Please ensure that the unit is prepared for treatment upon the technician's arrival. We ask that you be mindful of the technician's time, as well as the other residents waiting for treatment. Technicians cannot wait, so if you are not prepared, the treatment will be canceled, and a cancellation fee will apply.

Mandatory Evacuation Period:

All adults and children

All individuals and pets must vacate the premises for a minimum of FOUR (4) hours after treatment. Individuals with allergies, respiratory issues, or who are pregnant should vacate for at least **SIX (6) HOURS**.

Caged Pets Protocol:

Remove any birds and other caged pets (including fish and reptiles) from the residence during treatment. For fish tanks, turn off pumps and filters, and cover the tank with plastic wrap. Wait **24 hours** before reintroducing exotic animals.

Vacuum Thoroughly

- Vacuum carpets, rugs, upholstered furniture, and around baseboards to remove as many larvae and eggs as possible.
- Immediately dispose of vacuum contents in a sealed plastic bag outside the home.

Launder Infested Items

- Wash and dry clothing, blankets, and other fabric items on the highest heat setting they can safely withstand.
- Store clean items in sealed plastic bags or airtight containers to prevent re-infestation before treatment.

Remove or Cover Belongings

- Pick up and neatly store items from floors, under furniture, and in closets.
- Cover or remove any sensitive items (such as children's toys) from areas to be treated.

Move Furniture

- If carpet beetles have been spotted under or behind furniture, pull these items two feet away from walls so the technician can apply spray thoroughly.

Store or Cover Food & Dishes

- Seal or remove open food and pet food from treatment zones.
- Cover or remove dishes, utensils, and appliances from exposed surfaces.

POST-TREATMENT GUIDELINES

Mandatory Evacuation Period:

All adults and children

All individuals and pets must vacate the premises for a minimum of FOUR (4) hours after treatment. Individuals with allergies, respiratory issues, or who are pregnant should vacate for at least **SIX (6) HOURS**.

Caged Pets Protocol:

Remove any birds and other caged pets (including fish and reptiles) from the residence during treatment. For fish tanks, turn off pumps and filters, and cover the tank with plastic wrap. Wait **24 hours** before reintroducing exotic animals.

- Upon re-entry, open windows or run fans to help clear any remaining odor or airborne residue.

Avoid Immediate Cleaning

- Do not vacuum, shampoo carpets, or mop floors in treated areas for at least 1–2 weeks (or as directed) to allow the insecticide to remain effective.
- Light dusting in non-treated areas is acceptable but avoid thorough cleaning near application sites.

Monitor Activity

- You may see some carpet beetles for a brief time after treatment. Residual insecticide continues to kill pests as they come into contact with treated surfaces.
- If activity persists beyond 14 days, contact Pest B Gone for a follow-up inspection or re-treatment.

Maintain Cleanliness

- Continue vacuuming regularly after the recommended waiting period to remove any remaining eggs or dead insects.
- Launder infested or stored items occasionally to prevent re-infestation.

Long-Term Prevention

- Store clothes and fabrics in airtight bags/containers, especially if they are rarely used.
- Inspect and clean air ducts, baseboards, and hidden areas regularly, as carpet beetles can thrive in undisturbed places.

Follow-Up Treatments

- Severe infestations may require multiple applications. Adhere to the schedule your technician recommends for complete eradication.

No Pesticides or Cleaning Products

Do not spray any pesticides or cleaning products in treated areas after the treatment, as this may lead to control failure.
