To ensure the effectiveness of our treatment, please follow these preparation steps carefully:

PRIOR TO TREATMENT

Preparation for Treatment:

Please ensure that the unit is prepared for treatment upon the technician's arrival. We ask that you be mindful of the technician's time, as well as the other residents waiting for treatment. Technicians cannot wait, so if you are not prepared, the treatment will be canceled, and a cancellation fee will apply.

1. Remove Clutter

Clear away debris, mulch, and clutter from around the foundation of your home. Earwigs are attracted to dark hiding spots, so keep areas tidy to reduce habitat.

2. Trim Vegetation

Trim back bushes, shrubs, and plants that touch the side of your home. Keeping plants away from the structure limits pathways for earwigs to enter.

3. Seal Entry Points

Inspect doors, windows, and any cracks in walls or foundation. Use caulk or weather stripping to seal gaps, which helps prevent earwigs from entering.

4. Eliminate Moisture Sources

Address any moisture issues around your home. Fix leaky faucets, ensure proper drainage, and use dehumidifiers in damp areas to make your home less inviting to earwigs.

5. Evacuate People and Pets

Remove all individuals (including children and pets) from treated areas before the pest control service arrives.

6. Clear Treatment Areas

Move furniture, toys, and other items away from areas that will be treated to ensure thorough coverage and accessibility for the pest control technician.

POST-TREATMENT GUIDELINES

1. Do Not Disturb Treated Areas

Avoid cleaning treated areas for at least ****24 to 48 hours**** after application to allow the treatment to take full effect against earwigs.

2. Ventilate Treated Areas

After the waiting period, open windows, and doors to ventilate the area and help clear any lingering odors from the treatment.

3. Monitor for Activity

Keep an eye on the treated areas for any remaining or new earwig activity. If you notice persistent problems, contact Pest B Gone for a follow-up.

4. Regular Cleaning and Maintenance

Continue to monitor for signs of earwigs and maintain cleanliness. Vacuum any deceased earwigs and debris to minimize their presence.

5. Check for New Entry Points

Regularly inspect the home and surrounding areas for signs of new infestations or entry points and seal any gaps as needed.

No Pesticides or Cleaning Products

Do not spray any pesticides or cleaning products in treated areas after the treatment, as this may lead to control failure.
