



PEST B GONE INC WILL BE PROVIDING
INSECTICIDAL SPRAY TREATMENT

RESIDENCE ON _____ BETWEEN 9 AM TO 5 PM.

Preparation for Treatment:

Please ensure that the unit is prepared for treatment upon the technician's arrival. We ask that you be mindful of the technician's time, as well as the other residents waiting for treatment. Technicians cannot wait, so if you are not prepared, the treatment will be canceled, and a cancellation fee will apply.

Mandatory Evacuation Period:

All adults and children

All individuals and pets must vacate the premises for a minimum of FOUR (4) hours after treatment. Individuals with allergies, respiratory issues, or who are pregnant should vacate for at least ****SIX (6) HOURS**.

Caged Pets Protocol:

Remove any birds and other caged pets (including fish and reptiles) from the residence during treatment. For fish tanks, turn off pumps and filters, and cover the tank with plastic wrap. Wait ****24 hours**** before reintroducing exotic animals.

PRE-TREATMENT PREPARATION

Clean & Declutter

Sweep, vacuum, and/or mop floors, focusing on corners, under furniture, and along baseboards where insects may hide. Dispose of vacuum contents in a sealed bag outside your home. Clear clutter (toys, shoes, boxes) away from walls, windows, and doorways to provide good access for treatment.

Store or Cover Food & Kitchenware

Seal open food (including pet food) in airtight containers or remove it from the treatment zones. Cover or store dishes, utensils, and small appliances to prevent any accidental contact with the insecticide.

Move Furniture

If pests are seen behind or under furniture, pull these items two feet away from walls to allow the technician to spray baseboards and other hidden areas.

Remove or Protect Pet Items

Pick up water bowls, food dishes, bedding, and toys; store them in sealed plastic bags or place them outside the treatment area. Turn off and cover any fish tanks if they cannot be relocated; also turn off aerators to avoid drawing in airborne chemicals.

POST-TREATMENT GUIDELINES

Mandatory Evacuation Period:

All adults and children

All individuals and pets must vacate the premises for a minimum of FOUR (4) hours after treatment. Individuals with allergies, respiratory issues, or who are pregnant should vacate for at least **SIX (6) HOURS**.

Caged Pets Protocol:

Remove any birds and other caged pets (including fish and reptiles) from the residence during treatment. For fish tanks, turn off pumps and filters, and cover the tank with plastic wrap. Wait **24 hours** before reintroducing exotic animals.

Ventilate the Area

Upon returning, open windows and doors or run fans to circulate fresh air, clearing any remaining odors.

Avoid Immediate Cleaning

Refrain from sweeping, mopping, or wiping treated surfaces (floors, baseboards, walls) for 1–2 weeks or as advised by your technician. This preserves the residual effect of the treatment.

Monitor Pest Activity

It is normal to see some pests for a brief time following treatment as they encounter the residual insecticide. Activity should decline significantly within days or weeks.

5. Maintain Sanitation

- Keep food sealed, empty garbage regularly, and promptly clean up spills or crumbs. Good sanitation reduces the likelihood of new pest issues.

No Pesticides or Cleaning Products

Do not spray any pesticides or cleaning products in treated areas after the treatment, as this may lead to control failure.
