HOW TO PREPARE FOR TREATMENT

PRIOR TO TREATMENT Mandatory Evacuation Period:(inside treatment only)

All adults and children

All individuals and pets must vacate the premises for a minimum of FOUR (4) hours after treatment. Individuals with allergies, respiratory issues, or who are pregnant should vacate for at least ****SIX (6) HOURS**.

Caged Pets Protocol:

Remove any birds and other caged pets (including fish and reptiles) from the residence during treatment. For fish tanks, turn off pumps and filters, and cover the tank with plastic wrap. Wait ****24 hours**** before reintroducing exotic animals.

1. Identify Affected Areas:

Inspect your home for common entry points and areas where ladybugs tend to congregate, such as windowsills, corners, and near light fixtures.

2. Clear Indoor Spaces

Remove any items from windowsills, ledges, and floors in areas where ladybugs have been seen. This allows for thorough treatment without obstruction.

3. Seal Entry Points

Inspect windows, doors, and cracks in walls for any gaps. Use caulk or sealant to close these entry points to prevent further infestation.

4. Remove Food Sources

While ladybugs do not feed on food items in homes, maintaining cleanliness helps reduce other potential pests that could attract ladybugs looking for food.

5. Windows and Screens

Ensure that window screens are intact and properly fitted. Repair any tears or holes, as ladybugs can enter through these gaps.



POST-TREATMENT GUIDELINES

1. **Do Not Clean Immediately**

Avoid cleaning or vacuuming treated areas for at least ****7 days**** after treatment to allow the treatment to work effectively against any remaining ladybugs.

2. **Monitor for Activity**

Keep an eye on the treated areas for any signs of continued ladybug activity. If you notice new ladybugs or evidence of more, contact Pest B Gone Inc. for a follow-up reassessment.

3. **Ventilation**

Once the waiting period has elapsed, ventilate treated areas by opening windows and doors to ensure airflow and clear any residual odors from the treatment.

No Pesticides or Cleaning Products

Do not spray any pesticides or cleaning products in treated areas after the treatment, as this may lead to control failure.

Preventive Measures

Continue monitoring and sealing any potential entry points around your home to prevent future infestations. Check for and seal cracks around windows, doors, and utilities.

Maintain Cleanliness

Encourage ongoing maintenance of indoor and outdoor spaces to minimize future pest issues. Regularly clean windows, porches, and areas near lights where ladybugs are likely to aggregate.
