Preparation for Treatment:

Please ensure that the unit is prepared for treatment upon the technician's arrival. We ask that you be mindful of the technician's time, as well as the other residents waiting for treatment. Technicians cannot wait, so if you are not prepared, the treatment will be canceled, and a cancellation fee will apply.

Mandatory Evacuation Period:

All adults and children

All individuals and pets must vacate the premises for a minimum of FOUR (4) hours after treatment. Individuals with allergies, respiratory issues, or who are pregnant should vacate for at least **SIX (6) HOURS**.

Caged Pets Protocol:

Remove any birds and other caged pets (including fish and reptiles) from the residence during treatment. For fish tanks, turn off pumps and filters, and cover the tank with plastic wrap. Wait **24 hours** before reintroducing exotic animals.

PRIOR TO TREATMENT

Identify Infested Area

Locate Activity

Look for stink bugs around windowsills, doors, attics, and basements. Check for signs of entry points and clusters where they may be resting.

Inspect for Entry Points

Pay attention to gaps around windows, doors, and cracks in walls that could serve as entry points for stink bugs.
Clear the Treatment Areas

Declutter

Remove clutter from areas where stink bugs are present. This includes items on the floor, shelves, and countertops that may provide hiding spots.

Move Furniture

If possible, move furniture away from walls and windows to allow the exterminator full access to treating all affected areas.

Plan for Pets and Children

Relocate Pets

Keep pets away from treated areas during and shortly after the extermination process to ensure their safety.

Child Safety

Ensure that children are kept away from treatment zones until the exterminator indicates it is safe.

Pre-Treatment Instructions

Seal Food Items

While stink bugs are not particularly attracted to food, it is a good practice to seal food items and clean surfaces to prevent contaminating anything.

Close Windows and Doors

Before treatment begins, ensure that all windows and doors are closed to prevent exposed stink bugs from entering the treated areas.

Post-Treatment Guidelines

Mandatory Evacuation Period for interior spray:

All adults and children

All individuals and pets must vacate the premises for a minimum of FOUR (4) hours after treatment. Individuals with allergies, respiratory issues, or who are pregnant should vacate for at least **SIX (6) HOURS**.

Caged Pets Protocol:

Remove any birds and other caged pets (including fish and reptiles) from the residence during treatment. For fish tanks, turn off pumps and filters, and cover the tank with plastic wrap. Wait **24 hours** before reintroducing.

Cleaning

Do not clean treated surfaces for 14 days after treatment.

Monitor for Activity

After treatment, keep an eye on the areas where stink bugs were prevalent. If you see any signs of ongoing activity, report it immediately.

No Pesticides or Cleaning Products: Do not spray any pesticides or cleaning products in treated areas after the treatment, as this may lead to control failure.
