Mandatory Evacuation Period (For internal treatment Only)

All adults and children

All individuals and pets must vacate the premises for a minimum of FOUR (4) hours after treatment. Individuals with allergies, respiratory issues, or who are pregnant should vacate for at least **SIX (6) HOURS**.

Caged Pets Protocol:

Remove any birds and other caged pets (including fish and reptiles) from the residence during treatment. For fish tanks, turn off pumps and filters, and cover the tank with plastic wrap. Wait **24 hours** before reintroducing exotic animals.

PRIOR TO TREATMENT

Identify Infested Area

Inspect areas for signs of termite activity, including:

Hollow-sounding wood

Mud tubes on walls or foundations.

Termite droppings (small, pellet-like excrement)

Swarmers (winged termites) near windows or doors

Check Common Areas

Focus on locations with wood-to-soil contact, such as basements, crawl spaces, and near plumbing fixtures.

Clear the Treatment Areas

Remove Obstructions

Clear any furniture, boxes, or items away from walls and around the treatment areas, especially near foundation walls and in basements.

Access Exterior Areas

Ensure that the exterminator has access to the exterior of your home, including the foundation, decks, and any outdoor wood structures.

Provide Information

Share any observations about termite activity, including the type of termites (subterranean, drywood, etc.) if known, and any previous pest control actions taken.

Prepare Your Home

Depending on the type of treatment, you may need to:

Move soil away from the foundation if treatment includes soil application.

move any mulch or wood debris resting against the exterior of the home's foundation.

Post-Treatment Guidelines

Caged Pets Protocol:

Monitor for Signs of Activity

After treatment, keep an eye out for signs of termite activity, such as new mud tubes or wood damage. If you see any signs, contact Pest B Gone for a follow-up.

No Pesticides or Cleaning Products

Do not spray any pesticides or cleaning products in treated areas after the treatment, as this may lead to control failure.

Prevent Future Infestations

Correct Moisture Issues

Ensure proper drainage around your home to minimize moisture that attracts termites. Fix any leaks in plumbing and ensure gutters and downspouts direct water away from the foundation.

Maintain Distance

Keep firewood, mulch, and other organic materials away from the foundation of your home.

Conduct Regular Inspections

Schedule annual termite inspections to detect any new activity early.
