HOW TO PREPARE FOR TREATMENT

To ensure the effectiveness of our treatment, please follow these preparation steps carefully:

PRE-TREATMENT PREPARATION

1. Identify Wasp Nests:

Inspect your property for wasp nests, which can be found in sheltered locations such as eaves, sheds, trees, or bushes. Note the size and location of the nests to inform our technician.

2. Avoid Disturbing the Nests

Do not attempt to disturb or remove the nests yourself, as this can provoke wasps, leading to aggressive behavior.

3. Clear the Area

Remove any outdoor furniture, decorations, or items that may obstruct treatment areas around the nests. Clear a safe working area to allow the technician access.

4. Limit Food Sources

Remove any outdoor food sources that could attract wasps. Clean up any spills or crumbs from barbecues, picnics, or outdoor meals, and secure trash bins with tight-fitting lids.

5. Evacuate People and Pets

Ensure that all individuals (especially children and those with allergies) and pets are removed from the treatment areas before the technician arrives.

6. Secure Windows and Doors

Close windows and doors around the treatment area to prevent wasps from entering your home during the treatment.

7. Inform Neighbors

If nests are located on shared property lines or are affecting neighboring areas, notify neighbors to ensure they also take precautions.

POST-TREATMENT GUIDELINES

1. Do Not Disturb Treated Areas

Avoid interfering with treated areas for ****24 to 48 hours**** after treatment. This ensures that the wasp treatment can take full effect.

2. Monitor for Activity

Keep an eye on the treated area for any signs of wasp activity. If you continue to see wasps after the waiting period, contact Pest B Gone Inc. for a follow-up assessment.

3. Inspect for New Nests:

Regularly inspect your property for new nests, especially during the late summer and fall. If you notice any new nests forming, contact Pest B Gone immediately.

4. Maintain Clean Outdoor Spaces:

Regularly clean patios, decks, and outdoor dining areas to minimize food sources that can attract wasps.

5. Preventive Measures

Consider implementing preventive measures, such as hanging wasp traps or using scents that repel wasps in outdoor areas.

6. Education:

Educate family members about wasp behavior and safety. Encourage them to avoid wearing bright colors or floral patterns outdoors, as these can attract wasps.

Do not spray any pesticides or cleaning products in treated areas after the treatment, as this may lead to control failure.
